He said the world faces the largest humanitarian crisis since the creation of the U.N.

The U.N. warned of misery for millions in the affected countries. It said: "Without collective...global efforts...people risk starving to death." It warned of disease, of children with stunted growth, of "lost futures, mass displacements and reversed development gains". The EI Niño weather phenomenon has brought little rain, but a lot of the problems are man made. Conflicts are displacing many people. There are reports of aid convoys being attacked. Mr O'Brien said: "It is possible to avert this crisis, to avert these famines...these looming human catastrophes. It is all preventable."
