More children are suffering from "eco-anxiety". They are worrying about the future of Earth, climate change, pollution and biodiversity loss. Teachers want more lessons in schools about these issues. They say schools should have eco-lessons for all year groups. A campaign group said only four per cent of schoolchildren knew enough about the environment. The group said this is making more children experience ecoanxiety.

It wants to help children find ways to manage negative feelings. It said schools should make activities so children can teach their parents about protecting nature.
